- Please place all personal items: towels, sunscreen, etc. in a “beach” type bag.

- Students will need money for meals and snacks. We will stop for a morning snack. Students will eat lunch in the park. Students may bring their own snacks, lunch, etc., however, they will be responsible for keeping it secure and later disposing of it.

- Students will be responsible for all personal items—cell phones, headphones, earpods, etc., brought on the trip.

- Students must be in groups of **no less than 4** the entire day. They must remain with the **same** group the entire day. Getting lost or separated is not an excuse. Any student(s) seen by a chaperone/director with less than 4 will remain with the chaperone/director until they can be rejoined with their group.

- No student may leave the park for any reason. We will enter and leave the park as a group.

All students must return the **Medical Authorization and Medication Request forms** in order to go on the trip. These forms are due no later than **Thursday, May 1.** **Forms will not be accepted after Thursday, and no refund will be issued.**

Choir Trip Guidelines and General Information:

1. **CYPRESS FALLS HIGH SCHOOL POLICIES** - Refer to the Cypress Falls High School Choir Rules and Code of Conduct and the Cypress Falls High School Student Handbook for general rules of conduct. Remember, any student who does not comply with the rules as stated will face disciplinary action. All students and chaperones **MUST** check with a director for any questions or actions needing attention.
 - a. If rules are broken or any problems occur, parents will be contacted and appropriate disciplinary actions will be taken.
 - b. If public laws are broken, appropriate police actions may occur, including fines, arrest, detention, etc.
 - c. The director and chaperones are there for you. Without them, this trip would not be possible. They represent your parents. Please follow their instructions.
 - d. If you have been suspended or placed in DMC because of your behavior in our choral program, you will **not** be allowed to participate on this trip.
 - e. If you **did not** attend UIL Concert & Sightreading Evaluation, you will **not** be allowed to participate on this trip.
 - f. If you have any thought or plan to try to cause problems, break the rules, or break the law, **STAY AT HOME!**
2. **POSSESSION OR USE OF ILLEGAL MATERIALS IS PROHIBITED. THIS INCLUDES ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, DRUGS, TOBACCO PRODUCTS OF ANY KIND, OR NARCOTICS.**
3. **ALL MEDICATIONS – INCLUDING “OVER THE COUNTER” DRUGS –**should be:
 - a. listed on your medical form.
 - b. properly labeled in the original container with dosage instructions.
 - c. in a Ziploc bag, and given to Mrs. Douglas before leaving Cy-Falls.
 - d. Medicine will be administered to you as directed on the bottle by Mrs. Douglas or Mr. Perez. The medicine will be returned to you upon our return to Cy-Falls.
4. No water guns, water balloons, or other “toys” will be taken on this trip. You may take any electronic device, provided it has earbuds/headphones or make no audible sound. **YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR SECURING YOUR DEVICE THROUGHOUT THE ENTIRE TRIP.**
5. **VISITORS** - The director must clear ALL VISITORS. Family may come and meet you, but you will not be allowed to leave the group. If you plan to meet family while on the trip, it must be cleared with a note given to the director by **Thursday, May 1, to ensure that your parents are aware of this and give their approval.**
6. **TRIP ATTIRE –**
 - a. Swimsuits for Women:
 1. Your swimsuit must be a **one piece or a tankini.**

2. If we determine that your one piece swimsuit is inappropriate for any reason, we will ask you to wear a shirt.

b. Swimsuits for Men:

1. Men **must** wear a T-shirt, tank top or swim shirt.
2. Swim shorts should be of appropriate length. No speedos.

c. **Sandals/flip-flops must be worn at all time.** Flip-flops or sandals should be in excellent condition. We will not have materials to repair broken flip-flops or sandals.

d. Please bring sunscreen!

7. **PUBLIC DISPLAY OF AFFECTION (PDA)** - Inappropriate behavior between boys and girls will not be tolerated. Public displays of affection (close embraces, hanging all over each other, kissing, etc.) are not allowed between students on this trip.
